I would like to propose myself for ASPHER EB re-election. During the last few years I served as EB member I became involved in several ASPHER initiatives, among them: COVID19 Task Force (now serving as chair), SEEEPHI ERASMUS+ capacity building project (Sharing European Educational Experience in Public Health for Israel), Core competencies in applied infectious disease epidemiology as well as representing ASPHER in other activities including collaboration with APHEA, ECDC, WHO-Europe, EUPHA and the promotion of collaboration within the middle east context. If re-elected I plan to continue these activities, in the context of the post-COVID new normal period, adapting our lessons from SEEEPHI to the broader European context and strengthen the Israeli activities within ASPHER. As recent recipient of ASPHER research excellence award with special emphasis on health inequalities, I plan to deepen ASPHER engagement with health inequities, with strong emphasis on the role of climate change.
