Prof Nadav Davidovtich's manifesto to become ASPHER executive board member

I would like to propose myself for ASPHER Editorial Board re-election. During the past few years I served as an EB member and I became involved in several ASPHER initiatives, among them: COVID19 Task Force (now serving as chair), SEEEPFI ERASMUS+ capacity building project (Sharing European Educational Experience in Public Health for Israel), Updating core competencies in applied infectious disease epidemiology (UCCAIDE), as well as representing ASPHER in other activities including collaboration with APHEA, ECDC, WHO-Europe, EUPHA and the promotion of collaboration within the middle east context.

If re-elected I plan to continue these activities, in the context of the post-COVID new normal period, adapting our lessons from SEEEPFI to the broader European context and strengthen the Israeli activities within ASPHER. As recent recipient of ASPHER research excellence award with strong emphasis on health inequalities, I plan to deepen ASPHER engagement with health inequities, with special attention to the role of climate change.
