PROGRAM UPDATES

ASPHER's next generation agenda continues forward in full swing with three main types of engagement: 1. Long-term, funded or education-affiliated early career opportunities (ASPHER fellows and interns), 2. Long-term volunteer engagement (ASPHER Young Professionals Programme - YPP), and 3. Single-event opportunities (events, Young Researcher Forums, ASSETS, etc.).

In the past year, ASPHER has coordinated two Young Researcher Forums, which provide young and early career researchers with a chance to present their work and receive constructive feedback from a diverse range of judges. ASPHER additionally planned the summer training school, ASSETS, in conjunction with the first-ever in-person YPP event in Brussels! Similar to the YRFs, young professionals presented on a topic of their choice and then received feedback and engaged in a group discussion on their work.

The Young Professionals Programme had its third intake period as the group enters its fourth year after starting early in the pandemic spring of 2020. With a strong cohort of early career researchers engaged throughout ASPHER's various schools, the YPP provides a great resource to ASPHER in terms of engaging young professionals to support their work.

ASPHER has also greatly expanded its fellows programme, with six regular and associate fellows engaged in a variety of projects this year.

ASPHER interns, typically students working with ASPHER to complete a research project or practicum, have also contributed greatly in the past year. Currently there are five active interns.
