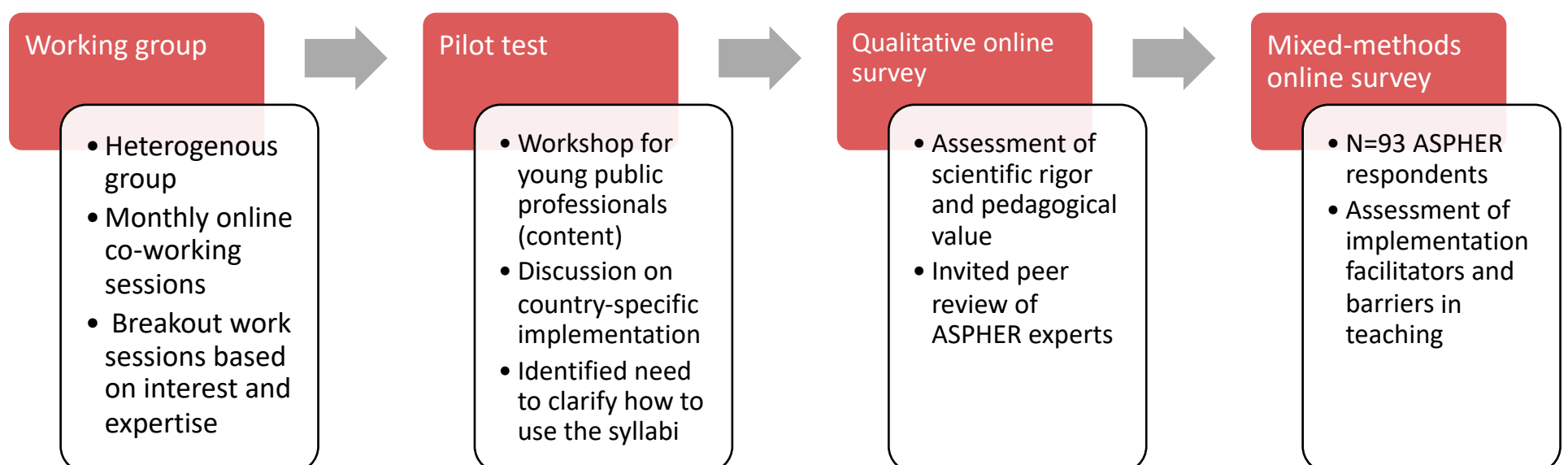
The open-access syllabi collection (co-developed with ASPHER):
