- SZP organizes original courses and continuous medical education in public health, including but not restricted to epidemiology, demography, medical, law, economy of healthcare, psychology, health promotion, geriatrics and gerontology, geriatric oncology, cardiology, endocrinology, lifestyle, environmental and social exposures, emerging infectious diseases and other public health threats. Public health courses are required by specialty programmes in postgraduate medical training for MDs and their framework programmes are in the respective training curricula for each specialty. Additionally SZP organizes continuous training for public health specialists, epidemiologists as well authorial advanced thematic courses for voluntary training in areas of research and professional expertise of its fellows and lecturers.
